1. This will be our third year of operating this program. To those who are returning-welcome back-for those who are joining us for the first time-welcome. Our programs philosophy is not based on winning or losing but on skill development, making new friends, learning good sportsmanship and having fun while at the same time getting valuable exercise. Parents and coaches please make a note of our philosophy. We want the players to want to come back week after week, year after year. As a Board we felt that there was no need to increase registration fees this year. Registration fees will only be raised when necessary to meet our expenses for running the program.
3. As noted above, sponsorship revenue helps us to meet some of our expenses of running this program. If you know of anyone who would be willing to sponsor a team, please let us know. The cost of a sponsorship is \$150.00.
